This license is issued subject to the following provisions:

1. License shall be valid upon signature of two selectmen.
2. License shall be valid only for the event, date, time, and place specified above.
3. Licensee shall be responsible for the conduct of the participants in the event and shall fully reimburse the Town of Seabrook for the extra expense in protecting the health and safety of the public, and for all injury, damage, and expense reasonably attributed to the event, and for which the town is liable.
4. Licensee shall obtain all necessary licenses, permits, or written permission from all governmental bodies having jurisdiction over the conduct of all or a portion of the event, and from any owner of land or buildings to be utilized during such event.
5. Licensee shall abide by the directions of the Seabrook Police Department and other governmental regulatory agencies having regard for the safety, health, and welfare of the public.
6. License shall be revoked by authorities upon any violation of Seabrook Code - Rules and Regulations: Chapter 155-3.

155-6. Power of enforcement.

Enforcement agencies are authorized to ensure compliance, and temporarily close down the entertainment upon refusal of proprietor or operator to comply or continue to comply with appropriate by-laws, rules and regulations or statutes.

155-7. Penalty.

Any person, firm or corporation willfully violating this regulation shall be subject to a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.) for the first, Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.) for the second, One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.) for the third violation within an administrative year (July 1 through June 30) with administrative revocation of the entertainment permit by the Board of Selectmen after a hearing, if requested, following the third conviction within a licensing year.

155-8. Validity.

If any section or part of a section, or paragraph of this chapter is declared invalid or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section or sections, or part of a section or paragraph of this chapter.

155-9. Relation to other legislation.

This chapter is intended to supplement, not to replace, any other statute, ordinance or other law regulating the subject to which it is addressed.

155-10. Severability.

In the event that any portion of this chapter should be declared to be invalid or void, it shall not effect the validity of any of the remaining.

155-11. Effective date.

This chapter shall become effective May 1, 1996.
